CBSE Registration



- CBSE registration will be done towards the end of September
- Students must keep their Aadhaar number ready.
- Keep the basic details of your child updated on school website.
- Any child opting for a 6th subject must inform the class teacher and submit an application about the same during the Final Registration process. No changes will be entertained by the CBSE thereafter.

Attendance



- Please ensure that your child attends school regularly. There is no substitute to classroom teaching.
- CBSE prescribes 75% attendance mandatory for the child to be eligible to appear for the Board exam.

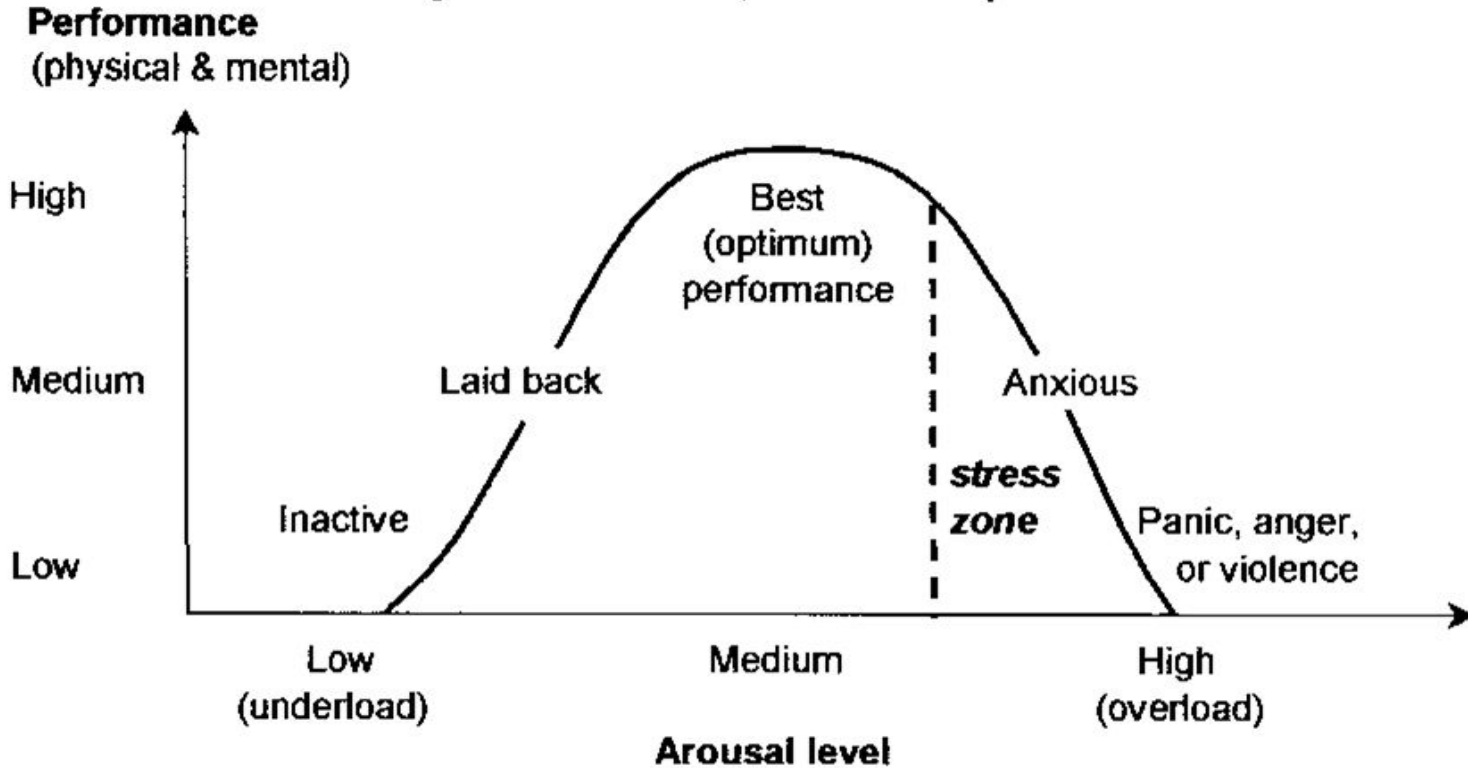
