Dear Parents

It gives me great pleasure to inform you that our school is initiating an Indo – U.K Exchange Programme with King's College School, Wimbledon in 2017-2018. Since King's College School is an independent day school for boys, the exchange is open only to boys who are currently studying in Grade 6 and 7.

The first part of the programme will take place during December 2017 with about 10-12 of our students going to London, accompanied by the faculty members of our school. The second part of the programme is scheduled for June 2018 when the British students, accompanied by their teachers, would come to Delhi.

As you know such an exchange program goes a long way in promoting international learning and knowledge that propels students towards acceptance and understanding of an array of different cultural and community perspectives. It brings self-development and awareness leading to enhanced self-confidence and self-esteem. We know that integration into another family leads to development of life-long friendships, fostering an appreciation of home and family. The students will be learning about British culture, language and way of living. They will have opportunities to visit interesting places in London which include Buckingham Palace, Big Ben, Houses of Parliament, Tower of London, Westminster Abbey, Natural History Museum and Science Museum, West-end theatre show, Wimbledon, etc. The students will collaborate and do a joint project, which is bound to broaden their outlook. In the second half of the programme our students would need to host their U.K friends and extend the Indian hospitality.

Students who are interested in participating in the 2017-18 Indo UK Exchange Program need to fill the attached form and return it to Ms Anjali Tulsiani by 10 February 2017. Shortlisting of students will be based on their responses to the questions, as enumerated in the form enclosed and feedback from teachers along with academic performance. Selected students would be required to submit a formal application form. They will be given all the details of the programme in an orientation capsule which will be held closer to the exchange programme. The approximate cost of the exchange will be Rs. 1, 30,000 only (Rupees one lakh thirty thousand only) per student if the group comprises 10 students. This amount is subject to change depending on the existing circumstances.
