Academic Session: 2019-20 Choice of Performing or Visual Arts in Class IX

Dear Parents,

In the forthcoming academic session, we offer your ward a choice of one of the following activities which will be held once a week for two periods.

Visual Art

Vocal Indian Music

Theatre

Visual Art: Art syllabus for class IX is designed so as the students can:

- Appreciate art works and art forms
- Learn various art mediums and techniques
- Get familiar with art related vocabulary and learn about a lot of artists during the session.

The syllabus is designed to ensure that the creative spirit grows, engages in art exploration and intellectual inquiry.

<u>Indian Vocal:</u> The curriculum aims to provide the students with an exposure to Indian music and to:

- Develop an aesthetic sense in the young minds so that they are able to appreciate the beauty of nature
- Learn basic ragas with aaroh, avroh, pakar and Madhyalaya bandish, tarana, etc. based songs and appreciate their own heritage
- Learn basic taal like teen taal, eaktaal and keharvha
- Learn folk songs, patriotic songs & seasonal songs.
- Introduce the history of Indian music along with basic knowledge of musical instruments and information about renowned musicians and singers

Students of vocal music will demonstrate cooperative learning and creative expression

Theatre:

These aspects provide a direct link between learning and play. The curriculum is so designed so as:

- To provide a focus for role play and encourage the student to imagine
- To help the students to work in a team and hone their acting skills
- To reduce stress by releasing mental, physical and emotional tension.
- To improve body balance, coordination, flexibility and control.
- To practise collaborative skills in various theatrical contexts.
- To apply skills of listening, articulation and awareness through the creation of performance as a member of an ensemble.

 Students will be able to deliver dialogues portraying different emotions and will be actively engaged in nukkad nataks, acting for school shows and competitions.

To choose a suitable activity for your ward for the session 2019 – 20, kindly fill in the form and return it to the class teacher by 5th April, 2019. Admittance to these classes will be strictly on a first-come first –served basis.

Please note that should your ward choose <u>Visual Art</u>, then you will be charged <u>Rs</u> <u>300/-</u> in the next fee bill towards the material that the student would be provided throughout the year in school.
