Re: Educational Trip to Germany in May 2016

Dear Parents

It gives me great pleasure to inform you that our school is continuing with the educational programme to Germany for the students of German of **Grade 7 and those of Grade 8 who are looking to take up German** in Grade 9 in the Academic Session 2016-17.

The German School is the only language school in Germany with a 16.000 m² campus, including the option to live on campus while learning German in Berlin. The park-like campus is a GREEN OASIS in the very center of Berlin, in über trendy Berlin Prenzlauer Berg. The green and the purple houses - built in 1867 - accommodated a school: Whether under Prussian Wilhelm II, under Hitler or later in Communist Germany - Berlin kids went to school here.

Accredited with International House World Organization, IALC International Association of Language Centres, EAQUALS- Excellence in Language Education, CSN Swedish National Board of School Aid, and TestDaF- language certification for University studies; GLS has received the Star School Germany award 5 times - in 2008, 2010, 2013, 2014 and 2015

GLS is the only language school in Germany with a 16.000 sqm urban campus including 2 hotels. The facilities on campus are second to none in Europe: 60 bright classrooms, a restaurant serving modern German food, apartments and hotel rooms of premium standard. All teachers have university degrees.

The trip will take place from 22 May – 30 May 2016. The trip will be accompanied by School teachers. The cost of the programme will be Rs 1,90,000 only (Rupees one lakh ninety thousand) per student.
