Steps to register for PSAT 2016:

Step 1: Fill the online registration form <http://www.usief.org.in/USIEFNewsLandingPage.aspx>

Step 2: Make payment using one of the methods listed below:-

- a. Cheque drawn in the name of 'USIEF-EAS Account' or
- b. Demand draft drawn in favor of 'USIEF-EAS Account,' payable at Chennai/ Mumbai/ New Delhi or
- c. Online transfer, to know payee details email your respective test center

Step 3: Your registration is complete after your chosen test center receives payment

Step 4: Admit card will be sent to your registered primary and secondary email addresses

Step 5: Print admit card and report to your respective test center with a government issued identification or a school identification card
