ABOUT THE QUIZ

This quiz seeks to generate interest in Thailand among the school-going students of Delhi-NCR, leading to greater understanding of the country and its people. It will help build bridges between the two countries, starting with the youth, so that future citizens of India are better informed about Thailand.

The questions will cover various topics and themes about Thailand, including:

- The land, its geography, natural features and treasures, wildlife and nature, including tourist destinations
- The people, history and culture, arts and literature, achievements in sports, science and technology, entertainment, education, famous personalities and events
- International relations and current affairs, including ties and links with India—cultural, ethnic, political—through the ages

CONTEST STRUCTURE

There will be 2 (two) levels of the contest. Level 1 will be a Written Preliminary Round.

From this, the top 6 (six) teams will be selected on the basis of their scores for the Final Stage Round. Each team will comprise 2 (two) members only.

WRITTEN PRELIMINARY ROUND

- All the teams that register for the quiz will participate in the written round.
- The written round will have 25 questions, including multiple choice and visual questions, which will be projected on the stage screen.

- One preliminary sheet will be given per team. Team members will need to write their names, grades, school name and answers clearly. Space will also be given for a team name. We will give a special prize for the **most interesting team name**.
- Teams will be given 20 minutes to complete the written round. No penalty for wrong answers.
- Special star (*) questions will be used to resolve ties on scores, if required.
- In case there is a tie even after the star (*) questions are considered, a sudden-death tiebreak will be conducted among the teams involved in the tie to select the stage finalists.

FINAL STAGE ROUND

Based on the scores from the Written Preliminary Round, the top-scoring 6 (six) teams will be selected for the Final Stage Round, which will comprise 5 (five) rounds, as follows:

Round 1

Progressive Round: interactive round; 1 question per team, no passing, differential scoring

Round 2

Audio Round: audio clues for teams; questions pass for bonus points

Round 3

Direct Oral Round: text questions on screen; questions pass for bonus points

Round 4

Video Round: video clues for teams to answer; questions pass for bonus points

Round 5

Buzzer Round: 8 questions on the buzzer; open to all teams; negative points for wrong answers. Additionally, each team will be given the chance to use a 'joker' in any ONE round, which will help them get double the number of points for correct answers. This 'joker' can be used in any of rounds 2, 3, or 4.

It cannot be used in rounds 1 and 5.

The quiz winner will be the team with the highest score at the end of the Final Stage Round. In case of a tie for the first two positions, a sudden-death tiebreak on the buzzer will be used to determine the winner.
