#### Dear Parents,

We welcome all of you to a fun-filled year of learning. Take a moment to imagine your child's world - letters, numbers, stories, puzzles, paints and play dough. As you talk to your child about their day at school, you shall celebrate in their world of imagination and creativity. For this, the children in nursery are encouraged, supported, and motivated to explore and learn in a creative way. We are looking forward to a great year! Our aim is to make this journey a stress-free and enjoyable experience for our little ones. Sparkling eyes and smiling faces will brighten up our classrooms once again as our little ones will share their experiences with us during circle time in class. We are waiting eagerly to listen to the enthusiastic and vivid descriptions of various things. Their high spirits and enthusiasm will be maintained through interesting and creative activities during this month. Before giving you information about what we have planned for the next few days, here are a few quick suggestions to help you and your child alleviate separation anxiety:-



- **Reading books** about the first day of school can be of great benefit. *It helps ease fears and promotes positive thinking about the initial days at school.*
- **Establishing a routine** the night before like having an early dinner and a scheduled bed time helps ease anxiety and stress in the mornings.
- This is a time of transition and feeling anxious is normal. Patience, preparation, understanding and establishing a routine helps ease these fears and reduce tears!
- **Review the almanac daily** as it might include important information about your child, important circulars, forms to be filled, health records etc.

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#### **Here is a short summary of the activities which we have planned out for this month.**

The **value** of the month is '**Making Friends and Bringing a smile**'. Transitions are exciting opportunities for our children to learn and grow. Our experience with this age-group has taught us that it is easier for children to settle into their new surroundings and routine when they have a special friend or two at school. With this view, we encourage them to talk about themselves and get to know other children and teachers through games and fun activities. This helps the child establish positive social relationships with peers.





The topic of the month 'Me and my family' is a fun way to start the year by letting the children talk about themselves, their family, home, friends, pets etc. This will help the students celebrate their individuality and learn about the similarities and differences. The topic will also help to create a sense of family in the classroom. We will "re-discover" ourselves and our family through puppet-shows and working on the "Activity Book" in the class.



### ORAL:

- "Circle Time"- children will talk about themselves and listen to their classmates. This will initiate the process of learning to express oneself in front of a group.
- Introduction to alphabets (a-z).
- Vocabulary exercises for letters **b, f** and **t**.
- Talking about Summer Vacations and going on a holiday.
- Rhymes related to the topic of the month.



### PRE-WRITING SKILLS:

- Activities like tearing/pasting, stringing beads, sorting, playing with dough and toys for fine motor co-ordination.
- Pattern drawing-**standing lines**.
