"Learning a new language helps rejuvenate the soul."

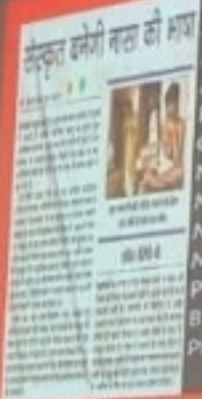
