Who can be a writer according to latest CBSE norms?

Any **student who is a grade lower than the student** with a legible handwriting and good comprehension and spellings. The writer should be someone empathetic, who can be sensitive to the child's needs and can help them read the question paper. A writer does NOT need to learn or read anything for the exam. They should only write as much as the child tells them to. It is better if one individual can write as many papers as they can for your ward to reduce risk of infection.
