CBSE Registration



- CBSE registration has been finalised. Any change of subjects will not be permissible now.
- School would not be able to schedule classes or exams for the sixth subject (if opted for). However, Board practicals for the subject would be administered through school as per CBSE guidelines.
- General Studies Project was assigned during Summer Break and should have been submitted by now to the Class Teachers. The grades of the GS project are reflected on the final board marksheet.

Attendance and Promotion Policy



- Please ensure that your child attends school regularly. There is no substitute to classroom teaching.
- CBSE prescribes 75% attendance mandatory for the child to be eligible to appear for the Board exam.
