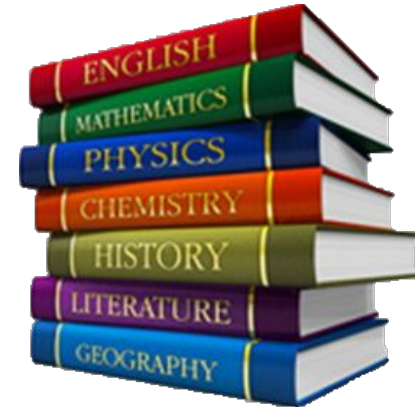

Academics-Road Ahead

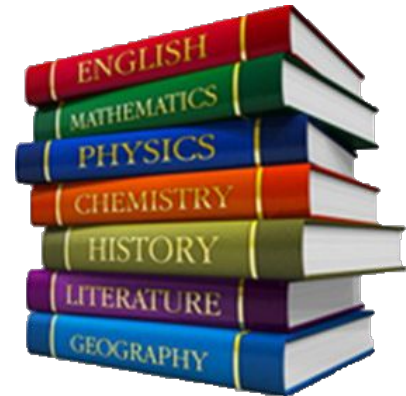


- ★ Mathematics Unit Test scheduled for 4th January is now rescheduled for 27th January 2021, Wednesday

ROLE OF PARENTS

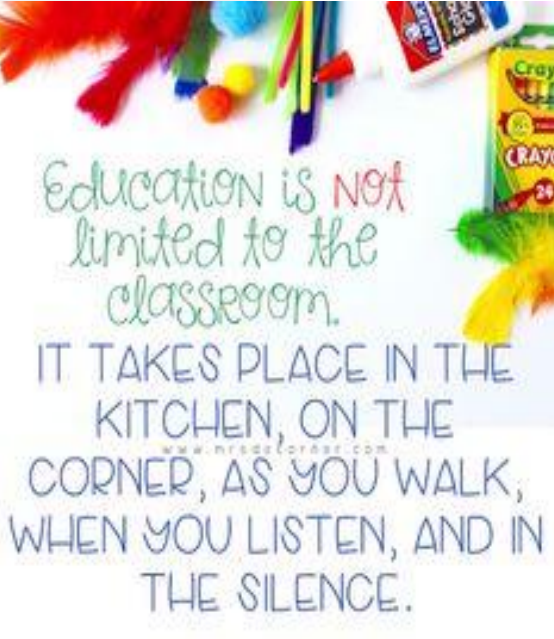


- Be a friendly parent
