

FIDE Olympiad Under-15 Delhi Schools Selection Tournament

Aadya Gupta (7-C) played the FIDE Olympiad Under-15 Delhi Schools Selection Tournament representing Sanskriti School. She finished 2nd scoring 8 points in 9 rounds and remaining unbeaten through the Tournament. She is therefore selected from Delhi by All India Chess Federation to visit Chennai for the FIDE chess Olympiad in Chennai next month where the selected few would get an opportunity to interact with grandmasters like Magnus Carlsen.

Aadya Gupta (7C) played the Chess Olympiad Torch Relay tournament in New Delhi hosted by All India Chess Federation for the first time. It was inaugurated by the Prime Minister and had more than 1500 players including Grandmasters too. Aadya won the 2nd prize in Under 13 Girls category securing 5/7 points and winning a cash prize of Rs 5000.
