- Do not feed the children while they are attending class



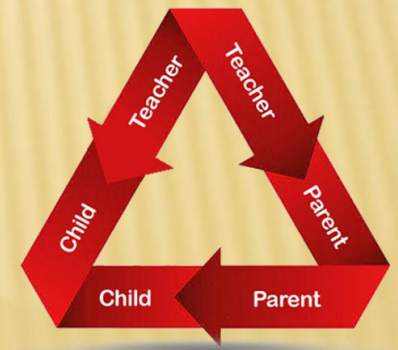
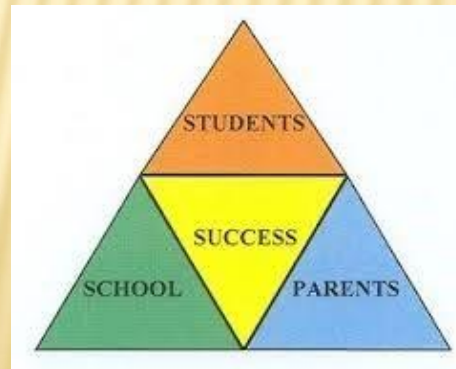
ACTIVITIES IN NURSERY.. Once School Opens

Keep a consistent sleep schedule

- Get up at the same time every day, even on weekends or during vacations.
- Waking up usually has to be at a fixed time, hence going to sleep is at your choosing.
- Set a bedtime that is early enough for you to get at least 7 hours of sleep.



Strictly NO 'screens' in bed

- Turn off electronic devices at least 30 minutes before bedtime.
- And don't keep those smartphones plugged in near your bed.
- Activate the Do Not Disturb feature, at a fixed time every night automatically

Establish a relaxing bedtime routine

- Keep the room at a comfortable, cool temperature.
- Keep the room as dark as possible.

IMPORTANT POINTS

- Take out time for your children
