

Indian National Trust for Art and Cultural Heritage(INTACH)- FILMIT 2019-20

This is a prestigious National Film Contest sponsored by the Helen Hamlyn Trust(UK). Filmit is a multi-cultural project that aims at nurturing cultural understanding, care and concern amongst school children through the exciting experience of making and sharing films.

Filmit offers a platform to engage students (classes 6-8) in developing short films (2 to 2.5 minutes) on their culture that can be showcased & shared through the internet with school children in other cities of India.

Eight students from Sanskriti school participated in the INTACH-FILMIT contest. And 7 films were created & submitted using various digital devices. They edited their films using software: imovies & Adobe premiere pro. Three of these films have been awarded in 4 categories.

The 3 awarded films are:

- Gi tag for Kovai Kora cotton sarees - awarded Best Concept. This film was created by Athavan Arvind of class(8E).
- Qutub complex movie - awarded Best narrator & best documentary film. This film was created by Shaurya Midha(8E).
- Intach Film - awarded Best direction. This film was created by Navvye Anand(8E), Kabir Goel(8E), Neil Binoy(7G) & Aadit Veer Singh(7G)
- Sanskriti school also got an award for maximum films submitted.
