

Dear parents

As you are aware, we will resume classes for all grades from July 11, 2022. The safety and well being of our students have always been our priority and keeping this in mind we follow the same traffic rules as in the month of March.

1. The road next to the school will be reserved for students walking to school and for the school buses. Parents can drop their wards at the end of the road (close to the Greek embassy) from where the students can walk towards the school.
2. It has been observed that parents coming to drop or pick their wards tend to park their vehicles or wait till the students are inside the gate. This creates traffic snarls causing unnecessary chaos and delay. Parents are requested not to wait and leave immediately after dropping them. Parents should also inform their drivers of the same. Vehicles parked in the lane outside school cause problems in parking buses, compromise safety and cause delays
3. Please note that Sanskriti School staff members will be deployed on both the roads to ensure the safety of our students and to ensure smooth and hassle-free movement of vehicles.
4. Both the aforementioned roads will function as one-way roads from 7:10-7:40 AM . This will be effective from 11th July 2022
5. The same rules will be followed in the afternoon from 1:30 pm to 2 pm.
6. Gate number 7, behind the 5th Block, will be operational. Staff and students traveling by their own vehicles can use that gate as well. Students using this gate must inform the respective class teacher before using the same. School staff will be deployed to take care of the security of the children.
7. We encourage our students to avail the bus services provided by the school. School transport is more environment friendly and at the same time will be an ideal solution for the traffic congestion outside the school in the morning and afternoon.
