CIRCULAR

The **Mukhyamantri Vigyan Pratibha Pariksha** for students studying in Class-IX is meant to identify and nurture the talent. The examination is conducted by Directorate of Education GNCT Delhi every year.

Scheme details:-The qualified candidates whose merit is within 1000 will be eligible with one time scholarship of Rs.5000/- and a certificate.

Date of Examination: The Exam will be conducted at various centers in DOE schools of Delhi on 27/11/2022 (Sunday).

Eligibility: (i) The students presently studying in Class IX in Govt., Govt. Aided and Unaided recognized Pvt. Schools including the Kendriya Vidyalaya, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya, School of NDMC, DCB, etc. in GNCT of Delhi.

(ii) Must have secured 60% marks in Class VIII in the session 2021-2022, 5% relaxation in marks for the students belonging to SC/ST and PH category.

Reservation :- 15% of the students belonging to the SC Category, 7.5% for students belonging to the ST category and 27% for students belonging to OBC category (Non-creamy layer) as per Government of NCT Delhi Revenue Department, 10% for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) those who have not covered under the reservation scheme for SCs/STs/OBCs, 4%(with in category) for children with benchmark disabilities, of which, one percent each shall be reserved for persons with bench mark Disabilities under clauses (a), (b) and (c) and one per cent for persons with benchmark disabilities under clauses (d) and (e) namely :-

- (a) Blindness and low vision ; (Visually impaired low vision)
- (b) Deaf and hard of hearing ; (Hearing impaired)
- (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy ; (LD)
- (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness ; (AID)
- (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under clauses (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness in the posts identified for each disabilities (MD)

Examination Pattern: The pattern of written examination will be as follows-:

Paper	Test	No. of Questions	No. of Marks	Duration (in minutes)
Paper-I	Mental Ability Test (MAT)	100	100	100
Paper-II	Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)	100	100	100

There will be no negative marking in examination.

Selection: (i) Qualifying Marks: Qualifying Marks for candidates from SC/ST/PH category is 32% in each paper and for others General/OBC & EWS categories it is 40% in each paper

(ii) The selected students as per merit and as per quota will be recommended for scholarship.

How to Apply: (i) The HOSs can register the details students on the Directorate of Education website www.edudel.nic.in with their own school login ID and Password► School Plant► Scholarship► School information entry form► Application form.

(ii) The schools can register their eligible enrolled students from 14/10/2022 to 30/10/2022.

(iii) The Science Branch, Directorate of Education, will generate Roll Numbers of the candidates and allot the Centers of Examination by 11 November 2022.

(iv) The HOS can take print out of the admit card, attest and issue 2 (Two) copies to the students on or before 25 November 2022.

(v) Safety norms with regards to covid protocol is to be followed by all the concerned.

Note:- Heads of Schools are requested to ensure the following (while submitting the application form):-

1. The candidates who claim to be under EWS (Economic Weaker Section) category, will have to provide Weaker Section) certificate (Sample attached) and which is valid for the year 2022-23.
2. The OBC candidates will provide the latest OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) certificate,
3. If EWS/OBC certificate is not provided by the candidate at the time of application, he/she will be treated as a general candidate.
4. The account/bank details of the candidates provided is to be that of the students only.

This issues with the prior approval of the competent authority.
