The activities will include instruction and skill-based reinforcement in

Reading readiness, Number work,
Prewriting Skills, Environmental Studies,
Art and Craft, Music, Clay, Dance,
Physical Education, Social/emotional
skills and Language development.





In the month of April, we will help the children to establish a routine in school and also help to prepare them for the year ahead.

We will introduce them to the world of "Colours" and "Shapes" through various hands-on activities, stories, songs and rhymes. We will do "Finger painting", "Tearing and Pasting" and Sorting activities which will help them to develop their fine motor skills. We will also introduce rote counting of numbers from 1 to 20, 7 days of the week, weather of the day and school prayer during the class activities.

Here is a short summary of the activities planned for the months of April and May:

Reading Skills







- * Introduction and Vocabulary exercises for letters **b** and **f** through interesting activities.
- *Show and Tell Children will talk about their favourite colour and favourite shape. This will initiate the process of learning to express oneself in front of a group.
- *Rhymes and stories related to various topics covered in the month.

Pre-Writing Skills

*Activities like folding, tearing/pasting, stringing beads, sorting objects, filling, playing with dough will be done through the month for development of fine motor co-ordination.
